

## The Trinity

God exists eternally in Three Persons: (each is equal)

### A. God the Father

Note: The phrase "God the Father" appears 12 times in the Bible and all in N.T.

[**John 6:27** ; **Gal. 1:1** ; **Gal. 1:3** ; **Eph. 6:23** ; **Phil. 2:11** ; **I Thess. 1:1**  
**II Tim. 1:2** ; **Titus 1:4** ; **I Pet. 1:2** ; **II Pet. 1:17** ; **II John 3** ; **Jude 1**]

Note: In the Trinity if the Father was the only one that is God, there would be no need of the phrase "God the Father".

### B. God the Son, Jesus Christ

### C. God the Holy Ghost

[**Col. 2:2** That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;]

[**I Thess. 3:11** Now God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you.]
